Biotech Consortium India Limited (BCIL), New Delhi, facilitated Licensing for Shigella Vaccine Technology developed at NICED, Kolkata with the support of ICMR to Hilleman Labs, New Delhi.

Dr. Purnima Sharma, Managing Director, BCIL at the Licensing Ceremony of the technology said that this collaboration brings together four institutes with complementary strengths and they are pleased to provide necessary assistance to the stakeholders in achieving the timelines for commercialization of this much-needed vaccine. The licensed Shigella vaccine candidate has been developed through support from ICMR, Okayama University, Japan and National Institute of Infectious Diseases, Japan. The translation of the licensed Shigella vaccine candidate to a market ready product will involve a stringent pre-clinical and clinical development pathway before it reaches the market.
